ORDINANCE NO. 12-06 -2016

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING LIBERTY TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NO. 7-6-2004 TO TERMINATE LIBERTY TOWNSHIP'S ENFORCEMENT AND ADMINISTRATION OF THE PENNSYLVANIA UNIFORM CONSTRUCTION CODE ACT.

WHEREAS, on July 6, 2004 the Liberty Township Board of Supervisors adopted Ordinance No. 7-6-2004 to adopt, administer and enforce the provisions of the Pennsylvania Uniform Construction Code Act, Act 45 of 1999, 35 P.S. §7210.101, et. seq.; and

WHEREAS, after several years of administering and enforcing the Pennsylvania Uniform Construction Code Act, the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Liberty had concluded that it would be in the best interests of the Township to cease administration and enforcement of the Uniform Construction Code; and

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Department of Labor and Industry was provided written notification of Liberty Township's intent to adopt this Ordinance ceasing administration and enforcement of the Uniform Construction Code on February 2, 2016, being more than the one hundred eighty (180) days required to provide said Notice pursuant to 34 P.S. §403.102(e).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Liberty, Centre County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

ARTICLE I. Repeal of Liberty Township Ordinance No. 7-6-2004.

Liberty Township Ordinance No. 7-6-2004 electing to enforce the provisions of Act 45 of 1999 is hereby repealed in its entirety thereby terminating Liberty Township's administration and enforcement of Act 45 of 1999, the Pennsylvania Uniform Construction Code Act.

ARTICLE II. Ratification.

The Liberty Township Code of Ordinances is hereby ratified and confirmed except insofar as the within amendment shall modify the same.

ARTICLE III. Repealer.

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are incorporated herewith are hereby repealed.

ARTICLE IV. Severability.

If any sentence, clause, section or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Liberty that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.

ARTICLE V. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall become effective as provided by law.
