

ORDINANCE NO. 27

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LIBERTY
ESTABLISHING TRAFFIC REGULATIONS OF MOTOR
VEHICLES IN THE TOWNSHIP OF LIBERTY, CENTRE
COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Liberty, in the County of Centre, and the State of Pennsylvania, as follows:

WHEREAS, Section 6109 and 3363 of the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code (Title 75) grant Municipalities the power to alter maximum speed limits within their borders, pursuant to engineering and traffic studies; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Liberty is desirous of altering the maximum speed limits on various streets and highways within its borders; and

WHEREAS, the appropriate engineering and traffic studies have been completed in accordance with the law.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it enacted and ordained, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the Board of Supervisors of Liberty Township, Centre County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

1. **Maximum Speed Limits**: Maximum speed limits are established on portions of specified streets, as follows, and it shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle, on any part of a street where a maximum speed limit applies, at a higher speed than the maximum prescribed for that part of the street:

<u>Street</u>	<u>Between</u>	<u>Maximum Speed Limit</u>
Township Route 864	Ridgecrest Drive to State Route 150	45mph
Township Route 866	Ridgecrest Drive and State Route 1002	35mph

2. **Signs:** Official signs establishing maximum speed limits shall be placed along side roads in accordance with the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code (Title 75).

3. **Violation:** Any person who violates any provisions of this Section shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine in accordance with the provisions of the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code, plus costs.

4. **Engineering and Traffic Studies:** This Ordinance is enacted in accordance with Section 6109(e) of the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code (Tile 75) relating to the requirements of engineering and traffic studies.
